"A picture is worth a thousand words" is a familiar phrase which addresses the natural ability of all people in all cultures to use imagery for communicating powerful information. Mental images, formed long before we learn to use language, powerfully affect not only our beliefs, attitudes, emotions, motivation and behavior, but also our bodies, health and longevity, for they lie at the very core of who we think we are. Once dismissed as "mumbo-jumbo" guided imagery is now finding widespread use for pain control, anxiety, depression and stress management, improved sleep, smoking cessation, weight control, creativity and peak performance training. Guided imagery is a tool that can help people from all walks of life gain new levels of empowerment.



MAP & DIRECTIONS



405 FREEWAY

North:

Exit at Jeffrey/University

turn LEFT onto University.

Travel to California, turn LEFT.

Travel to Bison, turn LEFT.

See directions from Bison below.

South:

405 Freeway: Merge onto 73 Southbound.

73 Freeway: exit at Bison (last toll-free exit).

Turn LEFT at the signal onto Bison.

See directions from Bison below.

BISON DIRECTIONS

Traveling on Bison, pass the four-way stop at California and continue on Bison to Health Sciences Road, and turn LEFT. Make an immediate LEFT at the fork on Health Science Road, and turn right into Parking Lot 83.

73 FREEWAY

North:

73 Freeway: exit at Bison (first toll-free exit).

Turn RIGHT at the signal onto Bison

South:

73 Freeway: exit at Bison (last toll-free exit).

Turn LEFT at the signal on Bison

PARKING INFORMATION
